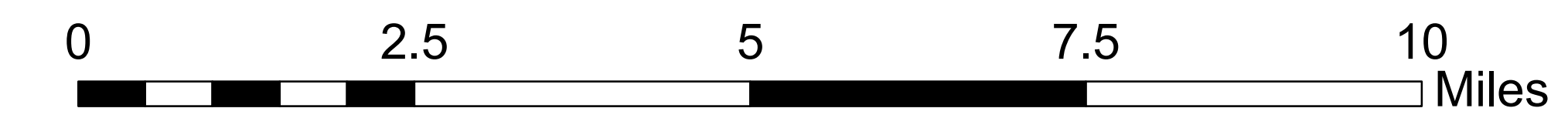


# South St. Louis County Forest Road and Trail Designation Plan February 7, 2007

**Forest Roads**  
Forest roads are roads used for the high speed travel of off-highway vehicles.  
This classification is based on the following criteria:  
1. Road width (minimum 12 feet)  
2. Road surface (gravel or better)  
3. Road use (off-highway vehicles)

**Minimum Maintenance Forest Roads**  
This classification is based on the following criteria:  
1. Road width (minimum 10 feet)  
2. Road surface (dirt or gravel)  
3. Road use (off-highway vehicles)

**Forest Access Routes**  
This classification is based on the following criteria:  
1. Road width (minimum 8 feet)  
2. Road surface (dirt)  
3. Road use (off-highway vehicles)

**Proactive Closure**  
This classification is based on the following criteria:  
1. Road width (minimum 8 feet)  
2. Road surface (dirt)  
3. Road use (off-highway vehicles)

**Hunter Walking Trail**  
This classification is based on the following criteria:  
1. Road width (minimum 4 feet)  
2. Road surface (dirt)  
3. Road use (hunting)

**ATV / OHM Trails**  
This classification is based on the following criteria:  
1. Road width (minimum 4 feet)  
2. Road surface (dirt)  
3. Road use (ATV, OHM)

**Non-Designated Routes**  
This classification is based on the following criteria:  
1. Road width (minimum 4 feet)  
2. Road surface (dirt)  
3. Road use (off-highway vehicles)

**Non-Motorized Access Areas**  
This classification is based on the following criteria:  
1. Road width (minimum 4 feet)  
2. Road surface (dirt)  
3. Road use (non-motorized)

**State Forest Boundaries**  
This classification is based on the following criteria:  
1. Road width (minimum 4 feet)  
2. Road surface (dirt)  
3. Road use (off-highway vehicles)

**Wildlife Management Areas**  
This classification is based on the following criteria:  
1. Road width (minimum 4 feet)  
2. Road surface (dirt)  
3. Road use (off-highway vehicles)

**State Parks**
